Here are the details of the available options:

Option A: You may purchase a steer for your own beef requirements - as an individual, a company or business, or a group of friends. This is the best Alberta Beef that you may ever eat. These steers have been fed the best, balanced feed rations and have been individually well-cared for (brushed, cleaned, fed, exercised, as only a 4-H member would do). The steers purchased can either be kept for personal use or sold to an onsite purchaser for that day's fair market value.

Option B: You may choose to spend a certain amount of money if you do not wish to purchase the full value of a steer. We will pool your donations with others who wish to purchase a steer in this way. Contact one of the leaders to discuss this with them. You will be recognized as a full buyer, even though you only purchased a portion of the steer.

Anyone wanting to butcher for personal use may have to wait a short time due to the Covid crisis and the increase in business for abattoirs. Talk to a leader if you would like to use one of the slots we have booked at an abattoir. If you would rather, the steers purchased can be sold to an onsite purchaser for that day's fair market value.
